

[AST FACT FOR PRIDE MONTH: The first well documented "pride" was started as a riot against police violence at the Stonewall Inn. Queer & trans people were routinely arrested for being "out in public." After finally having enough of this treatment, Stone DeLarverie, Marsha P. Johnson, and Sylvia Rivera all resisted arrest, sparking a movement towards lgbtqia+ liberation and freedom to live. Two of these women are trans and all them of are queer women of color. This year marks the 50th anniversary of the Stonewall Riots. Marsha P. johnson and Sylvia rivera are being honored with a monument in NYC to celebrate this uprising.

### WHAT WE'RE LEARNING

#### LITERACY:

Student's final literacy task of the year is to write an identity poem based on who they are. All poems are four stanzas long and will be read by each student to the whole class as a speaking work sample. We are finishing up the final pages of The Only Road as well as completing our final check-ins for literacy assessment.

WE WILL ALSO BE REFLECTING ON THE YEAR, CELEBRATING, AND CLEANING UP OUR CLASSROOM!

#### MATH:

**4ths:** Our fourth graders are ending by making connections between fractions and decimals, noticing patterns, and learning the start of numerical expressions.

**5ths:** Our 5th graders are ending with a review of the coordinate plane as well as connecting pattern recognition into being able to write equations that match patterns.

All students will take an in-depth math review assessment to help gauge their progress for not just this current unit, but also for units throughout the year.
