ODE Requires 2-3 daily hours/10-15 hours weekly of teacher led assignments. I am assigning 11 hours per week based on the above schedule.

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Handy Notes

- \star Kids (and most of us, honestly) thrive on routines, so keeping a routine is important.
- ★ Some of you have asked for a suggested schedule for your child. This is a suggestion please modify as needed.
- ★ For distance learning in MAY, the Oregon Dept. of Education mandates 2 to 3 hours of teacher assigned academic learning per day for 4th & 5th graders for May or 10-15 hours per week. This includes:
 - 60-90 minutes teacher led/assigned learning for math, language arts, reading, social studies/science each day in addition to below
- \star Additional, ODE names:
 - Up to 90 minutes *supplemental* math learning activities (Khan and prodigy can count towards this)
 - Up to 90 minutes *supplemental* language arts learning activities (seesaw, art, PE, etc. can count towards this)
 - \circ $\,$ Rotate social studies and science weekly (we aren't there yet but close) $\,$
 - \circ $\,$ 15-30minutes per day of PE/Art activities from our teachers or on own
- ★ The most important thing during this crisis is everyone's mental/emotional well-being, so you will notice lots of time for movement and breaks.
- ★ I will reach out to students and families for any student who consistently does not do the work to help problem solve barriers and provide support

What About Schedule Flexibility? YES!

PPS and myself fully support student flexibility with schedule/timing, however families and students need to know that this learning is not optional and takes the place of in person school. This is not homework, this is school. Here are the weekly totals we are working towards, in case you'd like to design your own schedule that is not 5 days a week, that utilizes evenings, etc.

- ★ Total Teacher Assigned Math & Language Arts Hours: 300-450 mins/week or 5 to 7.5 hours
- ★ Additional Practice for Math: up to 300 mins/week or 5 hours
- ★ Additional Language Arts (Read to self, etc.): up to 300mins/week or 5 hours
- ★ PE/ART: 75-150 mins(+) per week
- ★ Attend our class meeting each week (Mondays 10:130-11:15am)
- \star Attend all assigned virtual small groups
