What We're Learning

Reader's Workshop: Students worked hard to story map our Harry Potter movie, then think of a meaningful theme connected to the human experience. Previously, many students would say things like "the theme is magic" or "love." We are pushing to the next level which connects a specific point of learning to the story and then uses specific examples from the text/movie to support the theme. A complete them might be "The theme of this story was that part of friendship is sticking up for your friend," or "The theme was to focus on light rather than the dark challenges."

Math: I'm so proud of our mathematicians this week! Our 4ths became experts at using the skeleton model to multiply. Our 5ths finished up a short unit on volume and took the post-assessment to this unit. As requested by a few families, **use the attached strategy chart to see our math thinking**, for both small and larger numbers. A lot has changed in the world of math so it's handy to see these to connect with your student's mathematical learning. **Writer's Workshop:** This week, students reflected on their first quarter learning to write second quarter goals. We also practiced writing complete paragraphs using the theme to Harry Potter.

Social Studies/Science:

Students have been learning more about their government story role. When we return from break, we will dive into the impact of state and federal government policy on tribal lands for native people. We hope to display this learning at Riparian Festival.
